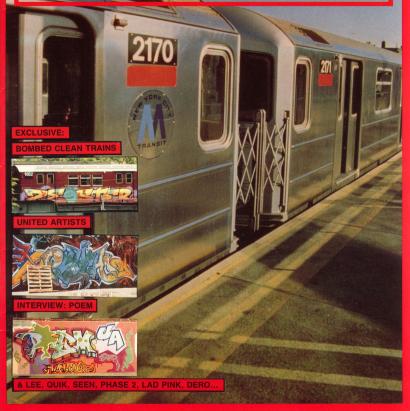

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HISTORY

THE HISTORY OF GRAFFITI

IT'S HARD TO SAY WHEN THE NEW YORK GRAFFITI PHENOMEA REALLY STARTED. IN GENERAL, SUPPOSEDLY IN THE LATE 60'S. THIS IS NOT QUITE RIGHT. EVEN IN LEONARD BERNSTEIN'S MUSICAL "WEST SIDE STORY" ONE COULD SEE TAGS BY THE TWO ENEMY GANGS: THE SHARKS & THE JETS, IN THE BACKGROUND SCENERY ON OF THE FIRST WRITERS WAS KILROY WHO WAS FIRST A SOLDIER IN EUROPE AND LATER BACK IN NEW YORK, USED TO DRAW FIGURES AND "KILROY WAS HERE" EVEN IN SUBWAYS AS FAR AS BACK IN THE 40'S. FURTHER BACK TO THE BEGINNIG OF THE CENTURY, HOBOS USED TO WRITE THEIR NICKNAMES ON THE CARGOTRAINS OF THE TRANS AMERICAN RAILROAD. THE HOMELESS WORKERS TRAVELLED GIGANTIC DISTANCES IN CARGO TRAINS ILLEGALLY AND WHOSE NAME WAS SEEN MOST HAD HIS FAME SECURED

BUT THINGS TO COME IN NEW YORK WERE REALLY NEW AND DEFINITLY UNPREDICTIBLE. THE BEGINNING OF SUBWAY GRAFFITI WHICH WOULD DEVELOPE TO A MASSIVE ART MOVEMENT CAN BE DATED BACK TO 1968/69. TIMES WERE HARD: NEW YORK CITY WAS CONSTANTLY BANKRUPT, SLUMS WERE BEING BURNT DOWN BY BUISSNESS PEOPLE SPECULATING ON GROUND PROPERTIES. MAFIA WAS FLOODING THE COUNTRY WITH HEROIN, RIOTS BROKE OUT AFTER THE ASSINATION OF DR.MARTIN LUTHER KING AND THE CRIME-RATE WAS REALLY EXPLODING / WAS UNSTOPPABLE. STREET KIDS LIVES IN AREAS WHERE NO POLICE-MAN WOULD DARE TO SHOW HIS FACE/ IT HAD BECOME A FIGHT FOR SURVIVAL. AND THAT REQUIRED SOME FORM OF UNITY IN THE 60'S AND EARLY 70'S THE CANG-PROBLEM HAS REACHED A POINT WHERE THERE WERE MORE VIOLENT GANGMEMBER THAN POLICE OFFICERS ONE COULN'T LEAVE THE NEIGHBOURHOOD THE TURF WITHOUT BEING CONFRONTED BY OTHER GANGS WITH SELF-MADE GUNS A FEW BLOCKS FURTHER ON. THE TURF BORDERLINES WERE MARKED BY GRAFFITI AND WARNED TO THINK TWICE BEFORE RISKING ONE'S LIFE. BAMA: "WE WERE CHILDREN OF THE 60'S. WHEN WE CAME OUT WE HAD OUR CHOICES: DOPE OR GANGS. BUT THERE'S ALWAYS THE VACCUM." THIS VACCUM WAS THE YET UNUSED CREATIVITY TO DO SOMETHING PRODUCTIVEN/WITH A SENSE TO IT. AND THEN IT HAPPENED. A FEW KIDS HAD ENOUGH OF SEEING BROTHERS DIE FOR NOTHING AND REFUSED TO JOIN A GANG. THE FACT THAT THEY DIDN'T BELONG TO A GANG DIDN'T SECURE THEIR TICKET TROUGH ENEMY TURE, THOUGH, GRAFFITI GAVE THEM THE ABILITY TO DO THIS. GANGS WERE FAMOUS BECAUSE THEIR NAME WAS WRITTEN ON WALLS. A SINGLE PERSON WHO DARED TO WRITE HIS NAME JUST AS OFTEN STRAIGHT THROUGH ANYONE'S TERRITORY, WITHOUT HAVING THE RISK STARTING A GANGWAR (LIKE A GANGMEMBER) FOUND RESPECT IN EACH GANG OF THE CITY, THIS PEACEFULLY AND RESPECTFULLY SEPERATED THE SINGLE WRITERS FROM THE VIOLENT GANGS IN THE EARLY 70'S.









THE SAVAGE SKULLS, SEVAGE NOMDAS, SEVEN IMORTALS AND BLACKSPADES WERE A FEW OF THE MOST IMPORTANT CANGS IN THE BRONX, BAMA-"AS A GRAFFITI ARTIST I ALWAYS FELT SAFE. 'MAN, IS THAT YOU? WE SEE THAT IN SAVAGE SKULL TERRITORY. MAN, YOU ARE RAD!

BUT SOON THE HIT (EARLY FORM FOR TAG) WAS MORE THAN JUST A PASS TICKET. JUST THE IDEA OF GETTING FAME FOR NOT DOING MUCH OTHER THAN WRITING WAS VERY TEMPTING BUT THEN ONE HAD TO DO MORE TO CAUSE ATTRACTION IN A MASS OF MANY ALL DOING THE SAME.

FIRST, ONE HAD THE MOST HITS. STITCH 1. TAKI 183, FRANK 207, JUST A FEW EXAMPLES OF TAG MASS-PRODUCTION IN BLOCKPRINT LETTERS CALIGRAPHICALLY FORMED HITS STARTED TO CATCH THE EYE MORE AND LIKE TRADEMARKS EVERYBODY STARTED DOING THEIR OWN STARS APPOWS AND SWIRLS STAY HIGH 149 AND HIS SAINT WITH JOINT, KOOL III WITH HIS ARROW IN THE "L", LIL FAME OR LEE 163 WHOSE HITS WERE EASILY DEPICKED FROM WHITIN A MASS OF OTHER TAGS. STYLE WAS BORN. SPRAYCANS SOON TOOK OVER SMALLER MARKERS AND ONLY EXTRA WIDE PILOT MARKERS WERE STILL USED BY KINGS AS REFORE MOVING ON FROM WALLS ON THE STREET GRAFFITI WAS SOON FOUND SPREADING FAST INTO THE SUBWAY STATIONS AND ON THE SUBWAY CARS. A FEW WRITERS REALIZED THAT THE TRAINS RUNNING THROUGH THE WHOLE CITY ENABLED THEIR TAGS ALL-CITY FASTER THAN BEFORE.

THIS WAY, THE WRITERS LEARNED TO LOVE THE SUBWAY ... FIRST INSIDES, THEN OUTSIDESNOT MUCH OF WHO DID WHAT FIRST CAN BE PROOVED NEW YORK IS JUST MUCH TOO BIG AND TOO MANY AND TOYS DID WHATEVER THEY FELT LIKE DOING WITHOUT PLANNING IT. SOME WERE DIFFERENT FROM THE REST. STAY HIGH AND OTHERS ENLARGED THEIR TAGS TO THE WHOLE HEIGHT AND LENGTH OF A CAR AND OUTLINED IT IN A DIFFERENT COLOR. THE IDEA OF OUTLINING THE TAG WITH MORE COLORS STARTED TO SPREAD. PEOPLE LIKE BARBARA AND EVE 62. STAR III AND STICH I, FOR EXAMPLE USED THIS TECHNIQUE A RELATIVELY

UNDISPITUTED FACT IS THAT THE VERY FIRST MASTERPIECE WAS BY SUPERKOOL IN 1972 IN THE 221TH STREET YARD. HE ONLY LISED TO COLORS PINK AND YELLOW HE FILLED THE BIG YELLOW-OUTLINED LETTERS WITH A FATCAP HE'D DISCOVERED. THIS TECHNIQUE ENABLED GRAFFITI TO DEVELOPE INTO IT'S FORM OF TODAY BY NOT JUST STYLING TAGS BUT STYLING THE OUTLINES AND THE COLOR FILL-IN'S. A PERSON WHO IMMEDIATELY PICKED UP THIS DISCOVERY AND CARRIED ON DEVELOPING IT, WAS PHASE II. HIS "BUBBLE STYLE" OR "CHECKERBOPARD PHASE PHANTASTIC" AND DOZENS OF OTHER IDEAS WERE BROUGHT UP AT THE

BEGINNING OF THE STYLE WARS ABOUT

TO BREAK OUT IN THE WRITERWORLD.

HISTORY

STAN 153 AND RIFF CARRIED OUT FIERCE BATTLE FOR THE TITLE "KING OF STYLE" IN THE START OF 1973. FROM HERE ON IT GET'S HARDER TO FOLLOW THE HISTORY BECAUSE EVERY OLD-TIME WRITER TELLS A DIFFERENT STORY ABOUT WHO WAS THE MOST IMPORTANT WRITER ON WHICH LINE AND HOW LONG. THAT'S WHY IT ISN'T SURE THAT THE FIRST WHOLE CAR WAS DONE BY FLINT 707 BY THE END OF 1973. BUT SURE IS THAT THE FIRST WHOLECARS APPEARED AT THIS TIME BRINGING FORTH YET AGAIN ANOTHER DIMENSION OF GRAFFITI WRITING BUT THE MTA STARTED TO REACT SLOWLY. WHEN ONE WOULD BE BEAT UP, HAVE TO PAY FINES, CLEAN THE TRAINS AND GO TO JAIL (UP TO ONE YEAR) IF CAUGHT AGAIN. IN 1974 NORMAN MAILER WROTE" A COMMUNION TOOK PLACE OVER THE CITY IN THIS PLANT GROWTH OF NAMES UNTIL...

THE FABULOUS FIVE WITH LEF LEADING THEM MADE THEMSELVES A NAME BY MAINLY DOING WELL CONCEPTED WHOLE CARS ON EVERY LINE FOR A LONG TIME. EVERYTHING CHANGED IN 1977. THE MTA CAME UP WITH A DETERGENT WHICH WAS ARLE TO WASH CRAFFITI TRAINS IN A CLEANING MACHINE. THE ACID FLUID DESTROYED THE ELECTRICAL SYSTEM, SO THAT THE DOORMECHNISMS AND THE OUTER SIDES OF THE TRAIN RUSTED, BUT WHATEVER HAPPENED THE JOB WAS DONE. THE TRAINS WERENT NECESSARY CLEAN BUT THE PIECES WERE DESTROYED. THE STINKING, SMEARED TRAINS DIRECTED THE PUBLIC'S DISGUST TOWARDS WRITERS FROM NOW ON THE DAYS WERE GONE WHERE WRITERS COULD WATCH THEIR PIECES ROLL BY IN THEIR ORIGINAL STATE FOR MONTH, DESPITE ALL THE MONEY SPENT ON THE GRAFFITI-PROBLEM IT SEEMED TO STAY THERE. THE FIGHT FOR FOR FAME EVOLUTIONIZED, NEW TECHNIQUES CAME UP WHICH MADE PIECES POSSIBLE WITH QUALITIES THAT PEOPLE DREAMED OF IN EARLIER TIMES. BY THE END OF THE 70'S, START OF THE 80'S, AFTER 10 YEARS OF GRAFFITI AND WORK OF THOUSANDS OF ARTISTS AND TOYS, THE ARTFORM HAS REACHED A POINT OF WORLD AWARENESS. THE BOOKS "GETTING UP" AND "SUBWAY ART" THE MOVIES "WILDSTYLE" AND "STYLEWARS" BROUGHT THE SUBCULTURE TO THE MOVIES AND INTO THE LIVING ROOM

MADE WRITERS LIKE SEEN, LEE, FUTURA 2000, BLADE OR ALSO DONDI AND ZEPHYR MADE THEIR LIVING IN GALLERIES. BUT AT THE SAME TIME SUBWAYS WERE BEING BOMBED, NEW SCHOOL WRITERS LIKE:









THE OTHERS AND DEVELOPED THE STYLES EVEN FURTHER. EVERY INCH OF THE TRAINS WAS BOMBED WITH TAGS AND EXELLENT PIECES AROUND 1985. BURNERS ROLLED BY, ON TRAINS, IN LAYERS. BOMBED TRAINS RAN OFTEN UNBUFFED, BUT WERE SECRETLY PULLED OUT OF SERVICE BY THE MTA ONE BY ONE. THE REASON WASN'T HARD TO RECONSTRUCT. THE MTA HAD STOPPED BUFFING THE TRAINS. A POSITIVE TURN IN NEW YORK CITY'S ECONOMY GAVE THE MTA MONEY AND A GOOD PART OF IN WAS AIMED TO DEFEAT CRAFFITI FOR ONE AND FOR ALL. AFTER HAVING TO ACCEPT THAT EVEN THE WARLIKE FORTIFICATION OF YARDS DIDN'T HAVE ANY EFFECT. THE DECISION WAS MADE TO BRING ON NEW TRAINS MODERN COMFORTABLE AND GRAFFITI RESISTENT. PAINT WAS EASILY WASHED OFF WITH WATER BUT THE WHOLE OLD SYSTEM COULDN'T BE REPLACED, SO THEN THE MTA STARTED TO OVERPAINT SOME OF THESE OLD TRAINS IN GREEN, AS SOON AS ONE OF THESE WAS SPRAYED ON, IT WAS TAKEN OUT OF SERVICE TILL CLEANED. BUFFERS WAUTED AT EACH TRAIN TERMINAL AND WORKED EVERY DAY. THE DECLINING NUBER OF WRITERS WAS CONFRONTED BY A GROWING NUMBER OF BUFFERS. THE WRITERS INTERESTS WAS DYING OUT AS NO ONE WAS USED TO WATCHING A FRESHLY PAINTED BURNER GO STRAITGHT TO THE BUFF. THE BOMBED TRAINS DISSAPERED ONE BY ONE UNTIL THE LAST GRAFFITI WAS DRIVEN INTO THE CONEY ISLAND BUFF WITH WORLD WIDE PRESS IN IT. WHAT WAS LEFT WAS A HAND FULL OF WRITERS WHO CARRIED ON BOMBING DESPITE THEIR INEFFECTIVENESS. A FEW FOTOS ARE ONLY REMAINING EVIDENCE OF A PIECE BEFORE IT DISSAPEARS FOREVER. THE LAST BOMBERS ARE : VEN, WANE AND THE TFP CREW, BUT ALSO PIAY AND SOME OTHER OLD SCHOOL WRITERS. WHILE GRAF CONTINUES TO SPREAD OUT IN THE WORLD, IN NEW YORK IT SEEMS TO HAVE DIED OUT ON THE TRAINS. THE HOPE WE HAVE IS THAT

AS SOON AS NEW YORK IS BANKRUPT

NEVER FORGET WERE IT CAME FROM!!!

AGAIN-SO WILL BE THE MTA.





WHAT DO YOUR PARENTS SAY TO GRAF MY MOTHER LIKES MY PAINTINGS. SHE USED TO WATCH TRAINS WITH ME, BUT MY FATHER NEVER LIKED IT. HE JUST THOUGHT THAT IT WAS JUST...IT HAD SOME CRIMINAL ELEMENTS TO IT-THAT IT WASN'T REALLY GETTING ME ANYWHERE. OVER HERE COPS CAN'T JUST COME TO YOUR HOUSE WITHOUT PAPERS, ON TOP OF THAT I WAS DOING IT FOR YEARS BEFORE THEY EVEN KNEW WHERE I LIVED OR ANYTHING, SO THEY DIDN'T BOTHER MY PAPENTS OF ANYTHING AND THE REST THING - MY MOTHER BELIEVED IN ME ANYWAY, I TOLD THEM - DON'T WORRY ABOUT IT, I'LL BE O.K. AND I WAS!!

THERE ARE ROUMORS THAT WAYBACK, THERE WEREN'T ANY COPS IN TRAINS IN YARDS 7

THERE WERE PLENTY OF COPS ALL THE WAY BACK TO 1972 - THERE WERE PLENTY OF ANTI-GRAF-SQUADS. NOW THEY CALL IT ANTI-VANDAL-SQUAD BUT IT BECAME MUCH MORE VIOLENT. BACK IN THE 70'S IT WAS CALLED THE ANTI-GRAF-SOUAD RECAUSE THAT'S ALL THEY DID - THEY WENT AFTER WRITERS, O.K., WHEN THE 2ND WAVE OF GRAF HIT NEW YORK, IT WAS IN '74/'75 AND THAT IS WHEN THE CITY WAS BROKE AND WE REALLY HIT HARD ALL THE WHOLE CARS CAME OUT. THERE WERE WHOLE CARS ON EVERY TRAIN THAT WENT BY WHO DID THE FIRST WHOLE CAR ?

NOT THAT I KNOW OF - SUPPOSEDLY SUPERKOOL 223" BUT I DON'T THINK IT'S TRUE, ...BUT I THINK NOBODY REALLY KNOWS...

I THINK IT HIST CAME OUT BY SUR-PRISE. NOBODY WAS REALLY PLANING TO DO THAT - IT JUST HAPPENED. SOMEBODY COULD HAVE HAD A LOT OF EXTRA PAINT OVER AND DECIDED TO FILL IN THE REST AND THERE IT WAS ! YOU DID ABOUT 150 - 200 WHOLECARS, MOSTLY ALONE ?

ABOUT 50% OF THEM I DID BY MYSELF. THE OTHER HALF I DID WITH THE "FABILLOUS FIVE" WE ALWAYS DID WHOLECARS, THAT'S WHAT WE WERE KNOWN FOR VERY FAMOUS FOR JUST DOING WHOLECARS!

HAVE YOU GOT A POTO OF YOUR FIRST WHOI FCAR?

I GOT A PICTURE, BUT IT'S VERY BAD, I TOOK IT AT NIGHT, TOOK IT FROM AN ANGLE L WAS USING A 110 CAMERA-THE LITTLE ONES,-THAT'S ALL I COULD

HOW LONG DID YOU STAY THERE ? DEPENDS ON THE PIECE - SOMETIMES A

WHOLE CAR TAKES 4-5 HOURS, SOMETIMES 9-10 HOURS I DIDN'T USE LADDERS, I CLIMBED ON THE SIDE OF THE TRAIN FOR LOTS OF DETAILS WE DID THAT WHOLE TRAIN IN ONE WEEKEND, FRIDAY NIGHT-CAME BACK SATURDAY NIGHT

STORIES SAY THERE USED TO BE YARD PARTIES ?

YEAH, GUYS WOULD CLIMB DOWN FROM THE TRACKS AND RUN DOWN THE STREET, GO TO MAC DONALDS ORDER A BUNCH OF FOOD COME UP AND CLIMB BACK UP WITH BACS FILL OF HAMBURGERS FRENCH FRIES AND SIT INSIDE THE TRAIN

AND HAVE PARTIES THOSE WERE INCREDIBLE TIMES. IF YOU WERE VERY QUIET, DIDN'T BREAK WINDOWS OR ANYTHING. IF YOU WERE VERY DISCIPLINED YOU COULD PAINT THERE FOREVER AND NOBODY WOULD KNOW, YOU COULD COME BACK DAY AFTER DAY.

HOW MANY CANS DID YOU NEEDS

ABOUT 200 CANS, WE RACKED THEM UP IN ABOUT A WEEK AND A HALE I USED TO BE ABLE TO RACK UP ABOUT 80 CANS A DAY 80 CANS A DAY AND ME AND MONO WENT AND GOT ALL THE PAINT IN ABOUT A WEEK AND A HALF. HE WAS WORKING AND I WASN'T SO I WAS WAITING FOR HIM TO COME OUT OF WORK HE'S A POLICE OFFICER NOW, BE-LIEVE IT OR NOTE

WAS IT FASY RACKING BACK THEN? VES AND NO WE PUT CANS IN THE COAT -10 CANS SOMETIMES, I WOULD GO I WITH SHOPPING - BAGS AND LOAD IT ALL UP. BUT AT THAT TIME YOU GOTTA RE-MEMBER HARDWARESTORES WEREN'T REALLY CONSIDERING SPRAYPAINT ROBBERY A PRIME THING. AND I THINK THEY JUST TOOK IT OUT OF THE TAX WRITE-OFF

BACK TO THE TRAINS DID YOU DO TUNNELS ? WHICH ONES ? YEAH BUT I DON'T * TELL THAT TO NOBODY



CAN YOU LIVE FROM SELLING CANVASES? I COULD IT'S HIST THAT IT'S ME I DON'T PAINT AS FAST AS THE ARTWORLD WOULD LIKE YOU TO BE. MY WORK HAS GOT A LOT OF SENTIMENTAL VALUE TO IT ... BUT IT'S ALSO NICE MAKING MONEY OF IT.

WHEN WAS YOUR FIRST WHOLE-TRAIN?

THANKSGIVING 1976, NOVEMBER-AND IT WAS CHRISTMAS-WHOLETRAIN BUT DONE THANKSCIVING SO THAT IT COULD BUIN THROUGH THE CHRISTMAS EVE. IT RAN FOR 10 DAYS COMPLETE, 10 WHOLECARS ONE DAY, THE WHOLE DAY TWO RUSH-HOURS, THE NEXT DAY, THEY SPLIT IT UP, 4 WHOLECARS HERE,2 WHOLCARS THERE. 3 WHOLECARS OVER THERE

HOW OLD ARE YOU NOW?

I'M 30 YEARS OLD 16 WHEN I DID THE WHOLE TRAIN PAINTED 5 WHOLECARS IN ONE NIGHT !!!

WHAT WOULD YOU DO IN AN EASY RACK-

SPOT TODAY? IF I COULD AFFORD IT-I'LL BUY IT. IF I CAN'T, I'LL TAKE IT, WHY NOT? IT SEEMS TAKING THE PAINT MAKES YOU MORE STRONGER WHEN YOU GO INTO THE YARD BECAUSE IT'S ALL A PART OF THE WHOLE THING, I GOT A LOT OF PAINT RIGHT NOW, I GOT ABOUT ABOUT 1000 CANS AT MY HOUSE, OLD RED DEVIL. OLD RUSTOLEUMS, OLD KRYLONS. ALL THE COLORS... IT FEELS GOOD TO GO TO YOUR RACK AND PICK OUT ANY COLOR YOU WANT.

ARE YOU DOING CANVASES NOW ?

I'M DOING A LOT OF CANVASES, THIS SUMMER I'M GOING TO DO A LOT OF WALLS, I'M PLANNING TO DO MAYBE 2 OR 3 BRAND NEW HANDBALL COURTS ALL OVER TOWN - BRONX, OUEENS, DEFINITLY 2 IN MANHATTAN

WHEN DID YOU FIRST BEGIN GRAFFITT

I BEGAN SPRAY TAGGING ON WALLS AT AGE 10, AFTER SEEING BLACK AND HISPANIC MOTORCYCLE GANG GRAFFITI BACK IN 1969. BY THE NEXT YEAR I HAD STARTED TAGGING TRAIN INSIDES, I DIDN'T PAINT THE OUTSIDES OF TRAINS UNTIL 1972. (I HAD BEEN TO SCARED TO GO ONTO THE TRAIN TRACKS UNTIL THIS TIMES

WHO WERE YOUR FIRST INFLUENCES TO PAINT TRAINS ?

WELL, MY GRANDMOTHER WOULD ALWAYS TAKE MY TO YANKEE STADIUM UP IN THE BRONX, SO I'D SEE GRAFFITI FOR HOURS DURING THOSE SUBWAY RIDES, BACK THEN I ADMIRED JACE 2. STAR 206. STAR III. AL 161. HNX FLINT 707 AND STAYHIGH 149, OF COURSE, AS N.Y.C. GRAFFITI EXPLODED I ADMIRED SEVERAL OTHER INNOVATORS AND STYLE MASTERS DURING DIFFERENT PERIODS OF TRAIN ART'S DEVELOPMENT DO YOU STILL DO TRAINS ?

I TRY TO PAINT AT LEAST ONE TRAIN A YEAR I STOPPED REALLY BOMBING BACK IN 1985

DO YOU MISS THE ACTION OF PAINTING TRAINS ?

AT FIRST IT WAS HARD TO ADJUST TO LIFE WITHOUT MY BOMBING ADDICTION. I COULDN'T HANDLE SITTING AROUND SATURDAY NIGHTS WITH MY WIFE DOING NORMAL THINGS, I MISSED HAVING THE MASTER BOMBING MISSION PLAN WITH THE CREW



YOU'VE BEEN CREATING GRAFFITI ORIENTED ARTWORK, RIGHT ?

YES, I BEGAN PAINTING ON CANVAS IN 1975. HOWEVER, FOR THE PAST 11 YEARS I'VE BEEN EXHIBITING MY WORK WITH GALLERIES AND MUSEUMS IN THE UNITED STATES AND EUROPE

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN PAINTING TRAINS AND THEN ON CANVAS ?

WELL. THERE'S NOTHING TO COMPARE TO THE GREAT NATURAL HIGH ONE GETS FROM THE ADVENTURE AND ACTION OF DOING A PIECE ON A TRAIN SOMETIMES THE DANGER, ACTUAL DIFFICULTY OF THE MISSION AND THE BEAUTIFUL OR DESTRUCTIVE END RESULT IS THE BIG BUSH!

PAINTING IN A STUDIO IS OF COURSE SAFER AND MORE CONVENTIONAL / TRADITIONAL. HOWEVER, THE BEAUTY OF MY PAINTINGS CAN LAST A FEW HUNDRED YEARS NOW, WHERE AS TRAINS ARE TEMPORARY YOU MENTIONED DESTRUCTION WAS

THE ACT OF TRAIN PAINTING DESTRUCTIVE ?

YEAR BOY! SOMETIMES I WAS JUST OUT TO BOMB! JUST FUCKIN' UP AN ELEMENT OF OUR OPPRESIVE SYSTEM. YOU KNOW I WOULD MAINLY BOMB A FEW HUNDRED OR SO THROW-UPS ABOUT FOUR NIGHTS A WEEK THEN UD SAVE MY GOOD COLORS TO CREATE A NICE WORK JUST ONE NIGHT A WEEK. I WAS A BOMBER! I CAN REMEMBER A TIME PAINTING AN A-TRAIN "DING-DONG" ONE ENTIRE SIDE. BUT WITH THROW-HPS FLOATING ONLY ON THE WINDOWS. HA! YEAH, SOMETIMES I MEANT ONLY TO BE



WHAT DO YOU THINK OF EUROPEAN CRAFFITT ?

I'VE SEEN SOME AMAZING PIECES AND STYLES DEVELOP HERE IN THE PAST FEW YEARS, THERE ARE SEVERAL WRITERS WHOSE STYLES I ADMIRE. I LOOK AT THE MOVEMENT ON TRAINS AND WALLS LIKE ROCK-N-ROLL. ALTHOUGH THE BEATLES, ROLLING STONES, BOB DYLAN, ECT WERE PIONEERS ROCK-N-ROLL IS STILL GOING STRONG NEARLY 30 YEARS LATER. NO, NO! GRAFFITI STYLES ? ORIGINALITY, HOPEFULLY BEING SOMETHING POSITIVE IN A STRONG VISIUALLY EXITING MANNER. HAVE YOU EVER BEEN CAUGHT
